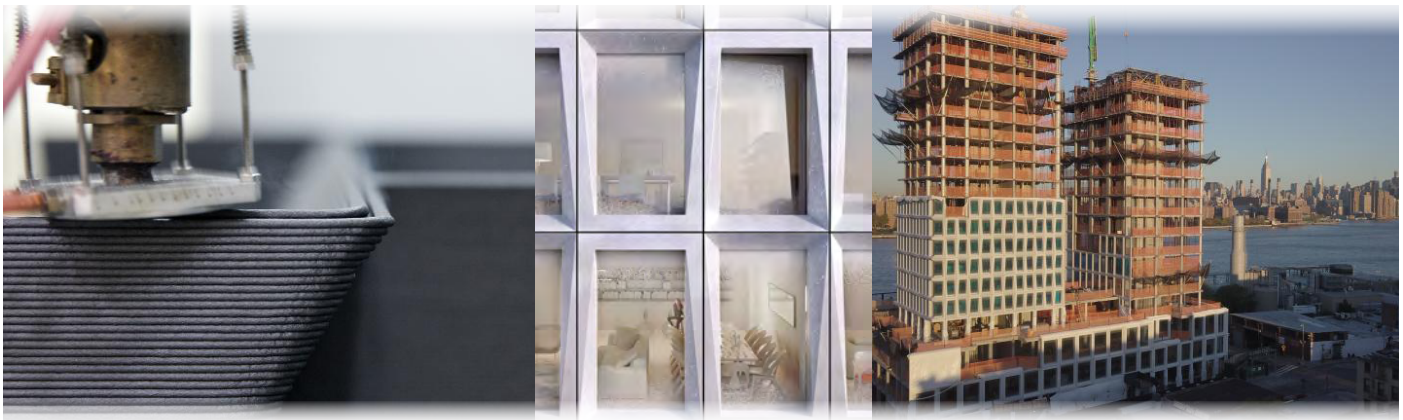

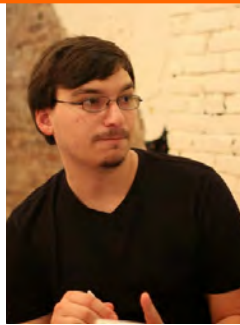

PRESENTATION SUMMARY

3D PRINTING SHAPES BUILDING INDUSTRY

Additive manufacturing, or 3D printing, is a wide field that is constantly advancing. Over recent years it has become more and more related to buildings and construction. This includes leveraging additive manufacturing to improve current construction methods as well as enabling new construction methods. This presentation will cover a general introduction to additive manufacturing. Recent projects will also be looked at including using additive manufacturing to reduce costs in precast concrete, and recent developments in concrete 3D printing. This presentation will mostly focus on work done at Oak Ridge National Laboratory's Manufacturing Demonstration Facility, but will include current work from others as well.

- Additive manufacturing can enable new designs and construction methods
- Additive manufacturing can reduce waste streams
- It has the potential someday to increase safety in construction by automating more of the process
- Additive manufacturing has the potential to lower costs in some areas

His main focus in this area is related to large-scale extrusion deposition additive manufacturing (AM) of polymer composites. His contributions over the past 6 years have led to multiple patents, R&D 100 awards and publications for materials, process and application development. He currently is the technical lead for large-scale extrusion deposition AM of thermoset materials, where himself along with his team are innovating technology and creating new supply chains by co-developing the world's first system developed to use these types of materials.






