

## CSI SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT

#### CSI GOLF TOURNAMENT SUPPORTS UT ENDOWMENT

The Knoxville CSI board recently announced that 50% of the proceeds from this year's golf tournament will go to the Knoxville Chapter CSI Scholarship Endowment with the UT Knoxville College of Architecture and Design. In 2005, Knoxville Chapter committed to raising funds to create an endowed scholarship that reached \$25,000 in 2007. The investment exceeds \$30,000 today and generates about \$2000 in scholarships each year. With the board's decision to contribute funds from the golf tournament, the endowment will continue to grow, creating more scholarships today and in the future.

The CSI Scholarship Endowment is awarded to a currently enrolled or admitted student to UT Knoxville College of Architecture and Design. They must have completed two years as an undergraduate or one year as a graduate student. Leadership skills and successful academic performance are considered by the college's scholarship section committee. There is a preference to continue to award, if eligible, the scholarship to the same student. Applicants shall also volunteer in organizations or events that promote the betterment of the building environment. Preference is also given to active CSI members.

The Knoxville CSI chapter supported the college with donations to the Solar Decathlon Design Build project and the summer Design Camp. In addition to the financial support, the professional support of the CSI members to the student chapter enhances our students' exposure to real life work product and experiences.

The College of Architecture and Design is pleased to continue this fruitful relationship with the CSI Knoxville Chapter and its members, who bring a wide range of experiences to our student body. We are grateful for this partnership.
