There is no charge for the seminar but you must register in advance to reserve a seat.

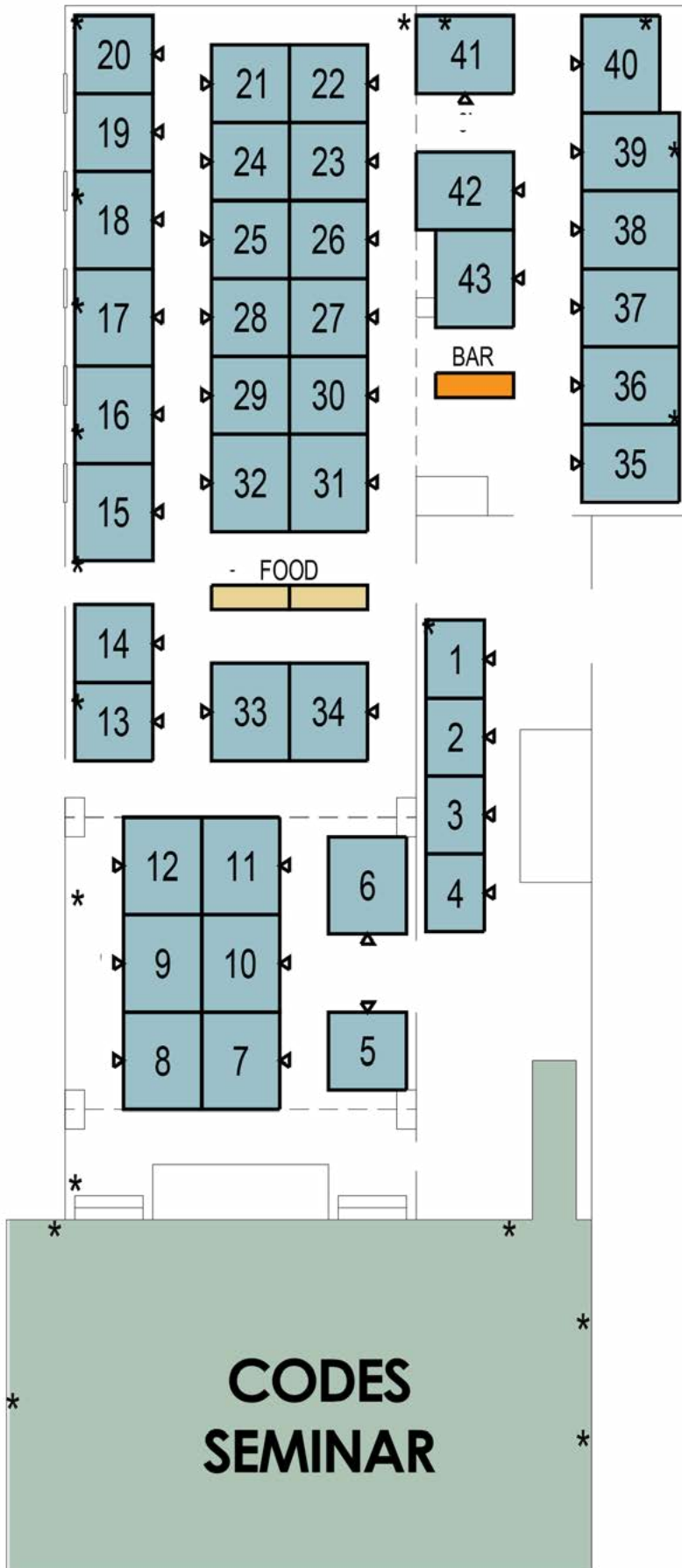
